

This year, the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), set by the United Nations, have been selected as an inspiration for the topics of the 9th International Youth Conference. The following is a description of these topics.

Clemate Action

The topic of Climate Action will be a focus of this conference, as it addresses pertinent topics related to the environmental risks that threaten the sustainability of natural resources, and the difficulty in renewing these resources after they have been irresponsibly misused. In addition, the consequences of this misuse will be outlined as well as the severe ramifications it has on future generations.

Clean Water and Sanitation

The most distinguished inventions in the field of sustainable development, specifically those ensuring access to clean drinking water and other related topics, will be discussed in the conference. In addition, topics such as achieving food security and investing in sustainable agriculture will be highlighted.

Responsible Consumption and Production

Prominent global brands and international organizations that have played an active role in preserving the environment and stressed its importance will be covered. These organizations have attained great success through the optimal use of renewable resources and their belief in community partnership to improve communities.

Life on Land

This topic will be led by public figures known across the world, whether on television or through social media, by sharing their interests in issues pertaining to wildlife, especially those that call for reducing the indiscriminate hunting of some rare and endangered animals. Awareness campaigns will be highlighted to draw attention to the severity of the issue and the important of preserving this natural wealth.

The Colon Water

Sea Life will reveal the deep secrets and hidden treasures of the underworld. A group of prominent international photographers who have dedicated their lives to uncovering underwater mysteries will







be participating at the conference. These photographers will share images, transfer their experiences through their footage and reveal the greatest threats to the sea.

Affordable and Clean Energy

Alternative energy issues and the need to work on the development of green fields and renewable energy sources will be a focus of this conference. This conference will highlight the importance of developing effective solutions for industrial energy.

Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure

This topic covers the fundamentals of environment-friendly industries which provide the infrastructure that corresponds to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in addition to highlighting the role of transportation and technology in supporting these goals.

The Discussion Participating in the Conference

- Each country or entity may have up to four representatives, of both genders.
- The conference targets youth between the ages of 18-30 years.
- Youth hostels, meals, transportation and visas for participants are included and will be provided by the Conference Organizing Committee, while the participating country or entity is required to secure airline tickets for their delegation.
- Participants are required to send a copy of their passports to issue an entry visa.
- The participant's name as it appears on their passport or identity card will be used in the conference unless otherwise stated.
- Discounted rates and offers will be provided for those wishing to stay in hotels, or for countries that wish to exceed the number of suggested participants.
- Participants will be provided with the hotel rates three weeks prior to the event.
- Participants are required to wear traditional clothes, which represent their countries, for the opening ceremony.
- Participants should become familiar with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) of the United Nations, and other related issues.
- The conference sessions will be conducted in both Arabic and English, with interpretation service provided.
- Participants will be provided with a detailed conference program two weeks prior to the event.
- The conference will run for six days, including the arrival and departure days. The arrival of the delegations to the Kingdom of Bahrain will be on 23/April/ 2017 and departure on 28/April/ 2017.
