

CONCEPT

Description: Model OIC is an academic simulation of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) that aims at educating participants about current trends in theory and practice of International relations, effective communication and multilateral diplomacy.

Vision: "Enhancing Muslim youth skills and capabilities, for the sake of revitalizing a leading Muslim Ummah."

Mission: Promoting belonging and loyalty to the Islamic Civilization and enhancing participants' intercultural skills, critical thinking as well as promoting a platform for youth, intellectuals and diplomats to meet together and discuss the problems faced by youth people.

Title: 5th Edition of International Model of the Organization of the Islamic Cooperation (5th IMOIC), a Global Summit

Main Implementing Organization: ICYF-DC

A) MOIC Clubs

General Information on MOIC Clubs:

- MOIC Clubs are established by university students at research centres, Youth NGOs or universities and supervised by academicians. It is right to say that it is autonomous student's activity where students have the chance of improving their skills and capabilities.
- 2. There are more than 10 national Model-OlC Clubs around the OlC region, including in Yemen, Kazakhstan, Jordan, Turkey, Azerbaijan, Malaysia, Palestine, Uganda, Mali and Somalia. Thus, establishing a MOIC Club will help in developing strong network between the Universities and Youth Organizations of the OIC Member and Observer States.

Model OIC Club Activities:

- a. Simulation of OIC Summit Annually: It is a simulation conference gathering the Head of States and Governments of OIC Member States once a year to deliberate on issues with grave concern to the Organization. Hence, the simulation will be focusing on the issues concerning Member or Observer States and OIC in general with participants acting as Head of Governments.
- b. Online Diplomatic Trainings: ICYF-DC Diplomatic training team will offer MOIC Clubs online training on rules & procedures of the OIC, diplomatic skills on yearly basis
- c. Cultural Events: Cultural events are activities organized by Model OIC Clubs where youth from different cultures or path of life come together and organize some events to share their own traditions. They also benefit from socializing together.
- d. Youth Day: On this special day, the Ministry of Youth and Sports as well as other relevant youth institutions use this opportunity to identify the issues concerning youth. In this regard, seminars, workshops, Model OIC Clubs can organize cultural events in collaboration with other institutions.
- e. Academic Seminars: This is a form of education given to a particular number of students, attending from different universities. Experts interactively discuss specific topics on a variety of issues. The Academy gathers official representatives from governmental and non-governmental organizations, university representatives and academicians to deliver courses in the best possible way for the students. During seminars, interactive issues in international relations, hot topics in the OIC countries, foreign policy strategies and many more are



discussed. After completion of seminars, the academy continues with trainings for International Model OIC Simulation Session. At the end of trainings, exemplary simulation of the Model OIC is organized and the most successful and active students among the participants will be selected to participate at the upcoming International Model of the Organization of the Islamic Cooperation (IMOIC).

B) 5TH IMOIC

Background:

- 3. The 1st IMOIC was successfully held on 12-17 July 2011 at the Sabanci University, Istanbul, Turkey, with the participation of 150 outstanding students from the OIC Member States top universities, and resulted with the conference's resolutions on three (03) vital issues of the OIC agenda at the time, as well as continuous establishments of Model-OIC national clubs. The 2nd IMOIC was also successfully held on 4-10 July, 2012 in Kazan, the Republic of Tatarstan, Russian Federation with participation of 150 students from the top-tier Universities in the OIC Member States, student leaders of over 10 national Model-OIC Clubs, prominent scholars, diplomats and the OIC Member and Observer States' officials. The 3rd IMOIC was successfully held on 2-6 July 2013 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, with participation of 130 students from the top-tier Universities in the OIC Member States, student leaders of over 10 national Model-OIC Clubs, prominent scholars, and diplomats
- 3. Islamic Conference Youth Forum implemented 4th IMOIC for Dialogue and Cooperation (ICYF-DC) in cooperation with the Mashhad Municipality of the Islamic Republic of Iran in Mashhad on 22-28 October, 2016 under the theme of "Empowering Youth for Peace, Solidarity and Development". Islamic Summit Simulation ended with resolution consisting of 63 articles and Youth Declaration.

Objectives and Goals:

4. Promoting positive Islamic image on international arena, holding different support kinds for struggle against Islamophobia and religious discrimination towards members of Maslim

communities are among the main objectives of the IMOIC a social event for students coming from OIC Member States and beyond. It encourages youth active in creation and establishment of intercultural and interreligious dialogue that seeking to bring together and disseminate expertise and knowledge about the life situations, aspirations and ways of expression of Muslim and non-Muslim youth. It also develops established network among the OIC Universities and Youth organizations, with the help of established MOIC clubs in all OIC Member States that will serve the idea of strengthening intercultural dialogue and provide training in the field of international diplomacy.

PARTICIPANTS:

5. Universities of Member and Observer OIC States are expected to send a delegation of 03 participants (BA and/or MA students of international affairs, Political Science or related social science fields). MOIC Clubs, established in 2017, are expected to send a delegation to report on their success on MOIC National Leagues. The local 50 participants will represent the Top Universities of Host country (TBC). The opening and closing ceremony of the conference is to be enriched by the participation of high-level local officials and international guests, consisting of leading academicians, politicians and experts. Total number of participants is to reach 170 students, who will be accompanied by the international media representatives and resource persons.

BSTRACT:

5th International Model OIC is a unique international simulation version of the OIC. Having no analogies in the world, 05 days Conference will take place in one of the host country. (TBC) Being supervised by ICYF-DC, the representatives of the OIC General Secretariat and academicians, and supported in organization by the participants, will be divided into delegations of heads of "O!C Member States", and simulate the real life OIC diplomatic module. According to the agenda of the Conference, 05 days will be dedicated for Rules & Procedures Trainings, practical training and simulation sessions of Islamic Summit, with discussion of its real life agenda. Delegates are going to take part in the sessions design to take into consideration the interest of "REPRESENTED STATE" as well as participant's personal field of interest, in order to product possible solutions for the issues tackling the OIC. The final day will be dedicated to the plenary session, where all the delegates will come together to vote for the resolutions they were working on during the working sessions. In the Model OIC simulations, students performed as diplomats and participated in a simulated session of the OIC. Session participants concentrated on research and investigation of international issues, accompanied with debates and consultations, developing solutions to OIC countries' problems, reflected in the final resolution of the conference. In order to represent the policies of the selected state, the conference participants introduced a variety of communication and critical thinking tools, i.e. public speaking, group communication, research, policy analysis, active listening, negotiating, conflict resolution, note taking, technical writing, as well as applying all mentioned above in the frame of diplomatic rules and procedures.

During the Conference, 04 panels delivered by the eminent scholars from different OIC Member State Universities, diplomats of OIC Institutions are to take place. Event Local Organizers expected to design an interesting program for cultural activities as well. Thus the project expects to be a social event, while promoting intercultural and interreligious dialogue as well as educating young men and woman in conducting diplomacy on international level
